As most of you know, my mother, Jean Marion Porter Williams went to be with her Savior on February 1st this year. She and my Dad were missionaries to Africa for many years. A segment of their mission work was in Kenya, East Africa and we worked with them at the beginning of our ministry in Mombasa. Daddy and Jim had purchased an eleven-acre plot of land to the south of Mombasa on which was built a church and Bible Institute. Years later Jim founded a Christian elementary school and this

in the middle of a Muslim/Pagan area with the intent of winning families for Christ and giving them hope in their lives. The property has also been used for youth camps for many years and so has therefore been quite a shining light in its community.

We are now going to enlarge and renovate the main assembly building which is multi-functional. It has up to this point been an open-air building with roof and floor and partial sides. We aim to enclose it, increase its size and turn it into a proper assembly hall. It is used for:

- Tiwi Baptist Church
- Tiwi Baptist Academy chapel services
- Graduation and wedding ceremonies
- Youth camps
- Pastors Conferences
- Seminars
- Annual District Music Festival (our school won 20 of 26 1st places in the one this year)



As a tribute to my mom and dad (Dad's still with us), we would like to dedicate the newly refurbished and enlarged building to them and the ministry they had in Kenya. The problem is, we need funds for this initiative. Soo....the purpose of this

letter is to ask as many people as possible to donate to the cost of this project. We are asking our own supporters and Mom and Dad's supporters to join in financially especially in memory of their labors there. We have figured the cost to be \$60,000. We currently have \$5000, so we still need to raise \$55,000.



Usually Jim is the initiator in all of these projects but my sister, Kathy Elmore and I would like to make it our project. We'd surely like to get this finished while Daddy, who is 84, is still with us and then we're going to try to get him out here for the actual dedication. Please help us to raise this money so that we can get started with the whole thing as soon as possible. We appreciate your faithfulness to support our ministries and those of you who supported Mom and Dad for so many years.
